Women's Concert Attire**

The goal of the womens' concert attire policy is to present a professional image for our audiences and blend as a single harmonious unit without drawing visual attention to any individual.

To achieve this goal the womens' concert attire policy has been developed as follows:

	WEAR	DON'T WEAR
General	plain unadorned clothing with plain fabric in a true black color	ruffles lace sheer velour metallics sequins embroidery chiffon beading cutouts velvet satin
Tops	blouse, tunic or pull over long sleeve 3/4 sleeve	T-shirts exposed cleavage exposed midriff
Bottoms	dress slacks full-length skirts full-length dress	ankle pants tights khakis short pants cargo pants casual pants denim leggings wide skirts
Shoes	plain comfortable completely black	patent leather exposed logos non-black buckles
Belt	plain black small black buckle	bright metal wide or noticeable
Socks	opaque / solid	see through / sheer
Jewelry	small stud earrings wedding and/or other modest ring one small watch	necklaces bracelets
Head	plain black headbands and hair clips	feathers rhinestones sequins

No other ornamentation, including hats or neck scarves, may be worn

Women preferring to perform in tuxedos shall conform with dress code for male performers.
